

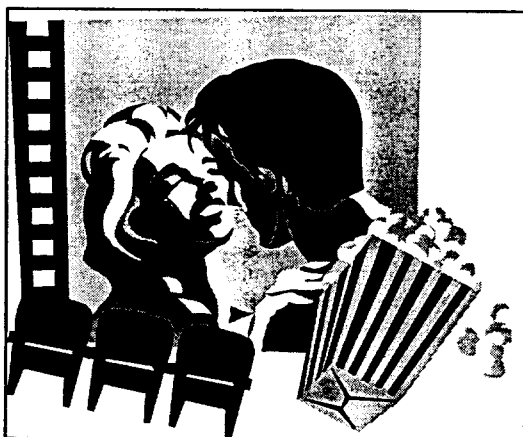

sity Dive Club. Fun and queasy stomachs was had by all at Steven Were's house.

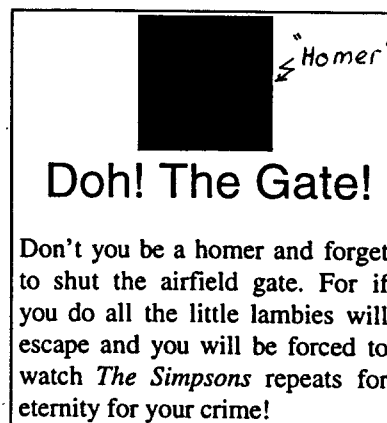

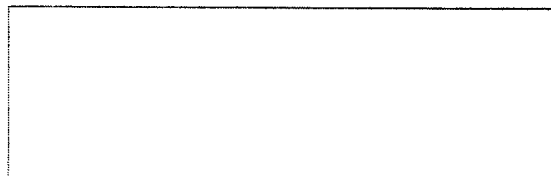
