Action Items:

- 4. New Hangar
 - a) Doors still need work

 - a) Neumatics still to do

 - d) need a battery & mount
 - e) need to replace the shelf in back seat.

Uni.

 - a) All AUGC equipment has been removed.

 - b) Leigh Stokes looking into alternative transmission type
 - c) Need new VHF radio for winch - maybe mount it on the inside roof
 - d) Avionics headset would be ideal
 - e) need to explore ways to box-in radio to make it more dust and water proof
 - f) Stranded cable for trailer winch has been purchased.
